We are pleased to invite you to the PenCon2020 Pensions Conference which will be held in **Lodz, Poland** on **April 23-24, 2020**. The conference has been organized biannually by the Department of Management and Pensions & Intergenerational Relations (PIR) Research Group, Lodz University of Technology (Poland), since 2009. It is a scientific event that gathers participants representing different universities, research as well as financial institutions. Since 2018, PenCon has an international range. We hope you join us and present your research.

Goal and Topics

PenCon is organized to create an opportunity to share experiences by both scholars as well as practitioners in the field of all the aspects of pensions. The conference topics specifically include (however are not limited to):

- Pension systems all over the world
- Demographics, ageing, longevity, elderly wellbeing and pension systems
- Pension and retirement decisions. Financial literacy
- Saving and consumption smoothing
- Legal and organizational aspects of pensions
- Investment policy of pension institutions
- Mission and CSR of pension institutions
- Risk, guarantees and redistribution in a pension system
- Contributions and benefits in pension systems
- Welfare state regimes and pension regimes
- Pension mathematics. Pensionmetrics. Longevity.
- Human Resources Management in the era of ageing societies
- Age management. Intergenerational relations in organizations.

Venue

PenCon will take place at Lodz University of Technology, Lodz, Poland. Lodz is situated in the center of Poland, nearby its capital city Warsaw (distance of 135 km). The communication between these cities is very convenient (1.5 hour by car, 2 hours by train). Both, Lodz and Warsaw have airports. Publication opportunities

Conference proceedings will be published both in online and print version by the Publishing House of Lodz University of Technology (for the evaluation purposes of Polish research institutions, the paper published in the monograph can be treated as chapters and granted 20 points).

The papers submitted for the PenCon Proceedings should be written in English of a sufficient quality. After a double blind review process they will be published with ISBN and will be submitted for indexing in The Conference Proceedings Citation Index, a Web of Science™ Core Collection database (PenCon2018 Proceedings have been

indexed in June 2019). The length of a paper should be 8-12 pages and its format must strictly follow the guidelines defined in the template that is available on the PenCon website (Information/Submission guidelines). We plan to publish the proceedings online and the monograph before the conference, thus we kindly ask you to stick to the deadlines mentioned below.

Fees

The conference fee is **EUR 150** (or PLN 650) and includes conference materials, publication, coffee breaks, two lunches and an evening dinner. The reduced fee for **PhD students** is **EUR 120** (PLN 520).
